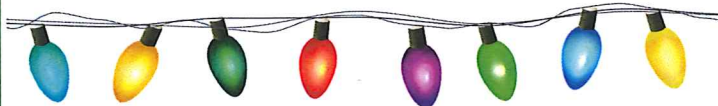
Skating Rink & Sliding Hill
