

**Glyndon Days Discussion 6/27/18**  
6:00 p.m. Glyndon Days Discussion Meeting #3  
City Hall Council Chambers

1. **Call to Order:** Mayor Cecil Johnson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
2. **Roll Call:** Council Members Present: Dave Owings, Justin Schreiber, Kimberly Savageau, City Clerk Wendy Affield and Administrative Assistant Susan Dayley.

3. **Parade Update from Dave Owings:**
  - Parade Announcer – Kristina Dernier
  - Sound System Coordinator: Bill Dally
  - 15-20 Parade Participants including the Glyndon Fire Department.
  - Owings will post the parade registration form on the Glyndon Days Facebook Page.
  - Owings questioned if anyone participates on Facebook's Swap and Shop – Owings explained, Hawley is using this to find vendors for their City's celebration and is wondering if Glyndon should look into using this option.
  - Mayor Johnson asked if a Grand Marshall has been chosen. Owings stated, not at this time. Mayor Johnson suggested Lloyd and Jeanene Seter.
4. **Street Dance Update from Justin Schreiber:**
  - Carl's BBQ would like to have a food stand at Glyndon Days. A few of the menu items will be ribs and pulled pork sandwiches. Schreiber informed Council Carl's BBQ's menu will not be competitive with the other food Vendor. Council agreed to have other options for attendees at Glyndon Days.
  - Working with Jim McLaughlin on trailers for the band. Schreiber explained two (2) fifth wheel trailers will be used with a canopy. Vehicles will be needed to pull the trailers.
  - Visited with Troy DeJong from Glyndon Rod and Gun concerning the beer garden during the street dance. Rod & Gun will discuss it at their next meeting. DeJong is expecting to have four (4) members serve only beer during the dance. Schreiber suggested the Rod & Gun keep the funds they make on the beer sales and the City will use the admission charge to pay for the band. Council agreed with the arrangement.
  - Schreiber stated, he has visited with the Chairman of Loco Days concerning how to work on getting sponsorships to help with the expenses of Glyndon Days. Schreiber explained they have a committee of twelve (12) people who visit with around twenty (20) sponsors. The sponsors usually donate between \$50.00-\$100.00. Schreiber was also informed the City should reach out to BNSF next year to see if they could get a grant for Glyndon Days.
  - Schreiber stated McLaughlin advised us not to do more than you can handle during Glyndon Days.
  - Porta potties are lined up.
  - Dayley suggested having something on Facebook requesting sponsorships.

**5. Community Picnic Update from Kimberly Savageau:**

- Savageau created a Facebook Event Page for the Community Picnic and requested everyone to share it.
- Cub Scouts will be serving the meal at the picnic.
- The Community Picnic will be from 6-8 p.m., Thursday, August 9, 2018.
- Affield informed Council instead of face painting we will be doing tattoos instead of face painting at the Picnic and Saturday Activities. Council agrees it will be less expensive and quicker to do.
- Affield suggested a ring toss game where you win a prize or a bottle of pop, this would also help alleviate the line for tattoos. Mayor Johnson suggested doing a bean bag toss as well and has a set the City may borrow. Savageau will check with the Fire and Police Departments to see if they will help with the bean bag toss.

**6. Saturday Activities Update from Joe Olson (Olson not present)**

- Animal Kingdom, Wrecking Ball, Candy Land Bounce N Slide and Bungee Run are reserved from Games to Go.
- Savageau stated the HR Committee is still working with the Maintenance Department concerning the work schedule for Glyndon Days.
- Olson will ask Nate Paulson if the Rescue Squad is doing their 5K Run.



- Porta Potties – 10-12 stalls @ \$75.00 each




