

Glyndon Days Discussion

6:00 p.m. Glyndon Discussion Meeting
City Hall Council Chambers

1. **Call to Order:** Mayor Cecil Johnson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
2. **Roll Call:** Council Members Present: Dave Owings, Justin Schreiber, Joe Olson, Kimberly Savageau, Police Chief Michael Cline and Administrative Assistant Susan Dayley.
3. **Parade Update from Dave Owings**
 - Discussed using a drone to video the parade and the crowd. Would like to put it on Facebook to help promote the parade in future years.
 - Owings stated there were currently 15 parade applications turned in. Does not include the Fire & Rescue or Color Guard.
 - Chief Cline suggested Owings contact the Red Cross, stating they like to be a part of the parade.
 - Taylor 'Pike' Peterson will be the parade announcer.
 - Amber Wang is singing the National Anthem.
 - Bill Dally is going to be the sound system coordinator for the announcers.
 - Owings stated there are usually a few participants that show up on the day of the parade.
 - Chief Cline reminded everyone there is no candy throwing during the car cruise portion of the parade until the Color Guard has gone through.
4. **Street Dance Update from Justin Schreiber**
 - The Hill Lounge will be having a band on Friday, August 11, 2017, Matt Aakre.
 - Morty's Bar & Grill will be having a band on Saturday, August 12, 2017, Low Standards.
 - Owners of The Hill Lounge and Morty's Bar & Grill agreed next year, 2018, the City of Glyndon will have a Street Dance on Saturday night.
 - Vendors are scheduled for Saturday, August 12, 2017 in the Community Center parking lot.
 - Schreiber stated, he knows of a few individuals that would like to donate towards Glyndon Days.
 - Council discussed the possibility of setting up an area for the Rod & Gun to sell beer during the activities in the park. Cline stated it is up to Council if they would allow beer to be sold, suggesting an area be fenced off with picnic tables to control entrance in and out of the beer garden along with someone checking ID's and attaching wristbands.

Schreiber will contact the Rod and Gun Club to see if they would be willing to sell beer from 12:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and checking ID's at the gate. Chief Cline said he would have extra officers on duty during that time. Chief Cline will provide wristbands for the

people that have proper ID and are over 21 years of age in order to consume alcohol. Cline suggested to have a radio station set up to play music during the event.

5. Events Update from Joe Olson



- Joe Olson will contact Tracy Tollefson in regards to vendors setting up either in the Community Center or High School.
- Face painting for Saturday still needs to be set up. Cline will contact students from the DGF high school art program to do the face painting at the picnic on Thursday, August 10, 2017.
- Kim the Clown does the balloon sculpting and is scheduled to come on Saturday, August 12th, 2017 for \$300.00.
- Minnow races? Tabled until next meeting.
- Will contact Gayle Robertson to see if the Lions/Lionesses will be serving a lunch on Saturday, August 12, 2017.
- Will contact the Wrestling Club regarding a Take Down Tournament to be held at the High School Football field.
- Matt Fischer and Joe Olson will be organizing the 3 on 3 basketball tournament. They have t-shirts donated for this event.
- Morty's will provide a list of events, times and dates of the activities they will be having. (golf tournament and bean bag tournament)
- The Hill will have a golf tournament and a band Friday, August 11, 2017.
- Jesse Camacho is interested in doing an art event with details to follow at a later date.
- Waiting to hear back from the Cub Scouts regarding the Barrel Run.
- The DGF Trap Team would like to do a raffle during Glyndon Days.
- Nate Paulson from the Rescue Squad will organize the 5k and 10k Run/Walk on Friday, August 11, 2017.
- Parade will start at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 12th, 2017.
- Will have a template list of events for a flyer promoting Glyndon Days at our next meeting.

Discussion was had regarding Games to Go for the Saturday event. It was decided to have the event operate from 1:00 p.m. through 5:00 p.m. at no charge to participate. Council directed Affield to order Games to Go with a budget of \$2,000 with no food since there will be vendors available to the public.
