PARKE AVENUE PROJECT UPDATE

Clay County Highway Department opened bids for the Parke Avenue Street and Utility Reconstruction project for the City of Glyndon. The County received two bids, with the lowest bid being significantly higher than the Engineer's Estimate. As a result of the high bid the County Board and the Glyndon City Council rejected the bids and will rebid the project at a later date with a proposed completion date in late 2019.
