Glyndon Police Department located at 218 Parke Avenue houses a Prescription Drop-off Safe for expired, unwanted or unusable prescriptions. Pharmaceuticals from medicine cabinets are responsible for more than 40% of home poisonings and are a target for drug abusers. Medications in standard containers may be deposited in those containers. Loose medication can be put into plastic bags available at the collection box and then deposited. Please ensure any liquid medication is enclosed in secure containers and placed in a plastic bag before depositing. **Syringes CANNOT be placed in the drop box under any circumstances.** This creates a hazardous situation for our evidence personnel. Once collected, evidence staff will ensure the medication is disposed of according to State and Federal laws.
