GROWTH IN GLYNDON



Mayor Johnson and the City Council are pleased with the progress of the new Southview Addition being built in the southwest corner of Glyndon. The infrastructure is complete and lots are being sold. If interested in purchasing one of the 83 lots please contact Kelly Richards at 701-729-1972.

The City is offering a 2-year Tax Abatement for new housing substantially completed by December 31, 2018 on the first \$200,000 value of the new home.

The City is also offering a \$1,000 utility incentive following the same terms as the 2-year tax abatement on homes substantially completed by December 31, 2018.

In the spring of 2018 Phase 2 Charleswood Addition, will begin construction east of the new Southview Addition and South of Centennial Addition. Jim Sullivan, owner of Sullivan Construction Inc., has plans for 51 homes to be built in this addition which will be apportioned for affordable housing.

Mayor Cecil Johnson is a lifelong resident of the City of Glyndon, former Chief of Police, sat on the Glyndon City Council and is now serving as Mayor of Glyndon. During his tenure as the Chief of Police he has watched the City grow from approximately 450 residents to current population of 1,394 (current census). Mayor Johnson is excited about this future growth and looks forward meeting and working with the new residents.
