

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRUCK PARKING
ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF GLYNDON

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GLYNDON

AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a truck of any description on any portion of the right of way on the north and south sides of U. S. Highway No. 10 in the Village of Glyndon from a point 100 feet west of the west line of Park Avenue in the Village of Glyndon to a point 100 feet east of the east line of Partridge Avenue in the Village of Glyndon.

Section 2. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.00 or imprisonment of not more than 30 days. Each day that the violation shall continue shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
