

ORDINANCE NO. 71

An ordinance establishing four-way stop signs at the intersection of Partridge Avenue and Second Street in the City of Glyndon.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLYNDON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The intersection of Partridge Avenue and Second Street is hereby designated as a four-way stop area and all vehicles entering said intersection shall come to a complete stop prior to entering said intersection.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Glyndon shall immediately place stop signs on all corners of said intersection for the purpose of informing the public that this is a four-way stop area.


Section 3. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not in excess of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage and publication.
