

ORDINANCE NUMBER 86

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADDING TO THE INTOXICATING LIQUOR ORDINANCE, WHICH ORDINANCE IS ORDINANCE NUMBER 74

BE IT ENACTED, by the City Council of the City of Glyndon as follows:

Section One. Ordinance No. 74, which ordinance is the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing Ordinance for the City of Glyndon, Glyndon, Minnesota, is hereby amended to add and amend a section, which section shall be known as amended Section Three to read as follows:


Section Three. No person, except wholesalers or manufacturers, to the extent authorized under state license, shall directly or indirectly deal in, sell or keep for sale, any intoxicating liquor without first having received a license to do so as provided in this ordinance. Licenses shall be of three kinds; namely, "on sale" and "off sale" and "on sale wine". Not more than four "on sale" licenses and four "off sale" licenses and four "on sale wine" licenses shall be granted by the City of Glyndon at any one time, and "off sale" licenses may be issued to a holder of an "on sale" license.

Section Two. The City Council of the City of Glyndon shall require, with every application, a receipt in a sum to be determined, from time to time, by the City Council of the City of Glyndon for a license fee, said license fee to be for a one year period from July 1 of each year through June 30 of the following year, except that the City Council may agree to prorate said fee for any part year if a license is issued during the course of any year following July 1 of said year.


Section Three. All of the other provisions of said Ordinance No. 74 are hereby reaffirmed and ratified.

Section Four. This ordinance shall be effective following its first publication.
