

ORDINANCE NO. 103

AN ORDINANCE FOR PARKING REGULATIONS IN THE CITY OF GLYNDON AND PERMITTING THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLYNDON TO ADOPT PARKING REGULATIONS AND PARKING SIGNAGE BY RESOLUTION ON ALL CITY STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF GLYNDON.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Glyndon as follows:

Section One. The City Council of the City of Glyndon hereby finds that parking regulations on city streets in the City of Glyndon require frequent modification, change or alteration, from time to time, and that such regulations regarding parking require speedy and prompt action to safeguard the public safety and welfare for the citizens and general public traveling or utilizing city streets and avenues.

Section Two. The City of Glyndon does hereby provide that the City Council, by majority vote, may adopt and enact resolutions regulating parking on city streets and avenues provided that the City shall promptly put in place appropriate signage regarding such regulations following enactment of any such resolution and shall cause appropriate signs to be displayed regulating parking on city streets and avenues.

Section Three. A violation of any parking regulation adopted by the City of Glyndon shall be considered a misdemeanor and may be punishable by law accordingly.

Section Four. This ordinance shall be effective following enactment and publication as provided by law.
