

ORDINANCE NO. 109

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF GLYNDON ORDINANCE NO. 94. REGULATING THE KEEPING OF ANIMALS WITHIN THE CITY OF GLYNDON.

BE IT ENACTED, by the City Council of the City of Glyndon as follows:


Section 1: Ordinance No. 94, Section 6, which is the Ordinance for regulating the keeping of animals within the City of Glyndon, Minnesota is hereby amend to read as follows:

The City of Glyndon may, by resolution, appoint an animal control officer for the City who shall aid and assist the police department of the City in the enforcement of this ordinance and in the capture and impoundment of any animal which should be unlicensed or should be creating a nuisance or should otherwise be in violation of any other statute or ordinance of the City or the State of Minnesota. Any animal so impounded shall be brought to an appropriate facility, and the owner, if known, shall thereupon be notified that the owner's animal has been so impounded. An impounding fee of \$25.00 shall be paid to the City. In addition to said impounding the owner shall pay the City the actual cost for the officer's fee and actual expenses. Further the owner shall pay all other charges incurred such as kennel charges, veterinary fee, and other related charges. All of the other foregoing shall be paid before the animal is released to the owner. In the event the impounded animal should be unclaimed after notice to the owner, if known, the animal may be destroyed in accordance with applicable state Statutes and regulations or otherwise disposed of in accordance with the same.


Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
