

ORDINANCE NO. 120

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING ORDINANCE NO. 64 WITH REGARD TO THE DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE WITHIN THE CITY OF GLYNDON

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Glyndon as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to place any garbage or refuse in or upon any street, alley, public property, public dumpster, or other public property of any kind and nature, nor shall any person, firm, or corporation place any garbage or refuse upon any private property owned by anyone else without the express consent of such other owner. In addition, no person shall throw, deposit, or place any garbage or refuse in any stream or other body of water.

Section 2. Nothing set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be construed to prohibit any person, firm or corporation from properly utilizing the recyclable program with regard to recyclable waste provided that such use is made in accordance with the rules and regulations adopted by the City of Glyndon for its recyclable program.

Section 3. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 64 pertaining to the collection and disposal of garbage and refuse shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Any violation of this ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, any person, firm or corporation in violation shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine of not more than Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700.00) and/or imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.


