

ORDINANCE NO. 122

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO CURFEW HOURS FOR MINORS WITHIN THE CITY OF GLYNDON

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Glyndon as follows:

Section 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish certain hours of curfew for persons under the age of 16 years within the city limits of the City of Glyndon so as to promote the health, safety and welfare of the said minors and of the residents of the City of Glyndon.

Section 2. No person under 16 years of age shall be or remain in or upon the streets, alleys, or public places within the City of Glyndon after the hour of 11:00 P.M. and before the hour of 5:00 A.M. from Monday morning through Friday morning and after the hour of 12:00 P.M. and before the hour of 5:00 A.M. from Friday night through Monday morning unless such minor is accompanied by parents, legal guardians, or other persons having legal custody and authority of such minor at the time when such minor is found upon the streets, alleys, or public places between the prohibited hours.

Section 3. No parent, legal guardian or other person having legal custody and authority of a person under 16 years of age shall allow or permit such minor person to be upon the streets, alleys or public places within the City of Glyndon during the restricted and prohibited hours as set forth in the preceding section of this ordinance.

Section 4. Any person found violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a petty misdemeanor and may be fined the maximum monetary amount permitted by Minnesota Statutes for violation of petty misdemeanors provided, however, that three violations of this ordinance by the same individual within any one calendar year shall be deemed to be a misdemeanor and violation thereof may result in imprisonment not to exceed 90 days and/or a fine of not more than \$700.00 or both.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
