

**CITY OF GLYNDON
ORDINANCE NO. 133**

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 64 which Ordinance No. 64 pertains to the collection and disposal of garbage and refuse in the City of Glyndon.

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 64 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new subsections 2(c), and 2 (d) which read:

(c) Animal Waste/Dead Livestock/Poultry

Existing feed lots and livestock or poultry farms shall have a set back of 1000 feet from schools and homes. All waste material shall be removed and disposed of on a daily basis. All livestock waste shall not be spread-injected or dumped in pits within the City of Glyndon or within 300 feet of Corporate Limits of the City of Glyndon. Flies and insects shall be controlled in such a manner not to cause a nuisance to surrounding property of a livestock or poultry operation.

- (i) Animal feedlots or poultry lots and their associated manure storage areas shall maintain the following setback limits in relationship to other allowable uses as follows:

To:	<u>With Total Confinement</u>	<u>All Others</u>
Residence	1,000 ft	1,320 ft (1/4 mi)
Church	1,320 ft (1/4 mi)	2,000 ft (1/4 mi)
Business	1,320 ft (1/4 mi)	2,000 ft (1/4 mi)
School	1,320 ft (1/4 mi)	2,000 ft (1/4 mi)
Recreation Area	1,320 ft (1/4 mi)	2,000 ft (1/4 mi)
Public Bldg.	1,320 ft (1/4 mi)	2,000 ft (1/4 mi)

- (ii) 100 foot setback from property lines, right-of-ways and ditches (to include a two rod grass buffer strip adjacent to ditch).
- (iii) The setback for manure spreading shall be 150 feet from dwellings, churches, campgrounds.

All Setbacks shall be measured horizontally and in a straight line, from the closest point of a structure, use, lagoon or district to the closest point of another structure, use, lagoon or district.

(d) Animal Units

The unit of measure used to determine the appropriate density at which livestock and poultry can be raised subject to the restrictions imposed by this Ordinance are as follows:

- A. One mature dairy cow, 1.4 animal unit;
- B. One head of cattle, excluding the above, 1.0 animal unit;
- C. One horse, 1.0 animal unit;
- D. One swine, .4 animal unit;
- E. One duck, .2 animal unit;
- F. One sheep, .4 animal unit;
- G. One turkey, .018 animal unit;
- H. One chicken, .01 animal unit;
- I. One goose, .2 animal unit;

For animals not listed in items A to I, the number of animal units shall be defined as the average weight of the animal divided by 1,000 pounds.


Only current, existing livestock or poultry operations will be allowed within city limits of the City of Glyndon.

The violation of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor and any person so violating the same shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$700.00 or by confinement in the County Jail of Clay County for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both.


This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
