

ORDINANCE #137
CITY OF GLYNDON

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING ORDINANCE #128 WITH REGARDS TO LICENSES AND REGULATING OF THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

Use or Possession of Alcohol by Minors.

A. Prohibitions

1. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 to purchase, obtain, possess or consume any alcoholic beverage in the City of Glyndon.
2. All other provision of Ordinance #128 pertaining to licenses and regulating of the sale and consumption of intoxicating liquor shall remain in full force and effect.
3. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, any person, firm or corporation in violation, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine of not more than seven hundred dollars (\$700) and/or imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days.
4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
