

ORDINANCE NO 138

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARTICIPATION IN NOISY PARTIES OR GATHERINGS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR REFUSAL TO DISBURSE THEREFROM

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Glyndon as follows:


SECTION 1. No person shall participate in any party or other gathering of people giving rise to noise, disturbing the peace, quiet or repose of another person within the City of Glyndon.

SECTION 2. When a police officer determines that a gathering is creating such a noise disturbance, the officer may order all persons present, other than the owner or tenant of the premises where the disturbance is occurring, to disburse immediately. No person shall refuse to leave the premises after being ordered by a police officer to do so.

SECTION 3. Every owner of such premises, or tenant in charge of such premises, who has knowledge of the disturbance shall cooperate with such police officer and shall make reasonable effort to stop the disturbance.

SECTION 4. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be, upon conviction of such violation, fined the sum not to exceed seven hundred dollars (\$700) or sentenced to the county jail for a period of time not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both.
