Ordinance No. 14.

granting Per-
mission to
maintain oil
reservoir
station

Be it ordained by the village council of the Village of Glyndon, in the County of Clay, State of Minnesota:

Sec. 1. - That permission and authority is hereby given and granted to the Standard Oil Company, a company corporation organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Indiana, to maintain for a term of Fifty (50) years upon the following described property, to-wit: The Northern Pacific railway right-of-way, at the N.W. intersection of Parke Avenue and Front street, warehouse, tanks, and other buildings necessary for its business, and to store therein illuminating oils, coal oils, naphtha, gasoline and other mineral oils or fluids, the products of petroleum in quantities sufficient to meet the requirements of its said business.

Sec. 2. - All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. - This ordinance shall be in force and effect on and after its passage and acceptance by the said Standard Oil Company.
