## **ORDINANCE NO. 155**

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE REMOVAL AND PLACEMENT OF SNOW FROM CITY STREETS, BOULEVARDS, AND RIGHT-OF – WAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF GLYNDON

## SECTION 1

Depositing Snow on Streets. No person engaged to move, blow or plow snow upon or off of any private property or city right-of-way within the city shall cause or permit any of the snow so removed, blow, or plowed to be deposited upon any street or street right-of-way within the city. The prohibition contained herein shall apply to the occupants of any such property, their agents, employees or independent contractors. The occupants of the premises or the persons requesting the snow to be removed or the persons who are actually removing the snow in some place other than upon the city streets and snow shall not be piled so as to interfere with the vision of motorists approaching any intersection. Other than from adjacent sidewalks and driveways, no snow shall be placed upon the boulevards.

## Section 2

Removal of Snow and Ice by City. Any snow or ice not removed in accordance with Section 1 may be removed by the city at the expense of the owner or occupant of said adjoining lot, by assessing the necessary expenses thereof, along with an administrative fee to be set by resolution of the City Council, and applied against said owner in the form of a special assessment.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
