ORDINANCE

No. 19

AN ORDINANCE granting permission to Henry Thibideau of Glyndon, Minnesota, to erect and maintain on the property described below, Office Building, Pumps, Underground Storage Tanks and other buildings necessary for the conduct of his business, and to store therein illuminating oils, naphtha, gasoline or any other mineral oils or fluids, the products of petroleum, in quantities sufficient to meet the requirements of his business.

In consideration of the sum of one & no/100 dollars (\$1.00), as rental receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, be it ordained by the incorporated Village of Glyndon, Clay County, Minnesota that permission and authority is hereby granted to Henry Thibideau, of Glyndon, Minnesota for a period of ten years from date to maintain and operate on the following described property located within the incorporated limits of the Village of Glyndon, County of Clay and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

N. W. corner of the Intersection of Main Street and Partridge Avenue adjoins Lot #10 in Block #1 of the Original Townsite of Glyndon, Minnesota.

A private drive-in service station and to construct thereon, office building, driveways and to install pumps and underground storage tanks necessary for his business and to store therein, illuminating oils, coal oils, Naphtha, gasoline or any other mineral oil or fluids, the product of petroleum, in quantities sufficient to meet the requirements of said Henry Thibideau's business.

Section 11. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 111. This ordinance shall be in force and effect on and after its passage and acceptance in writing by said Henry Thibideau.
