Village Ordinance No 3

An Ordinance providing for the licensing of
Dogs.

The Village Council of the Village of Glyndon
do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. For every dog over six months
old owned or kept in the Village of Glyndon
there shall be paid to the Village Clerk on or
before the first day of June of each year a
license fee as follows:- For each male dog
one dollar (\$1.00), and for each female dog two
dollars (\$2.00). The licenses issued shall be
numbered consecutively in the order they are
issued, and each dog shall wear a collar on
which shall be inscribed the number of such license.

Sec 2. The Village Clerk is hereby instructed to
post and maintain in his office a list of all dogs
licensed for the current year, and shall furnish
a copy thereof to the Village Constable, and shall
also from time to time furnish said Constable
with a list of such dogs as are subsequently licensed
during the year.

Sec 3. The Village Constable is hereby instructed
to take into his custody as soon as possible after the
first of June in each year all dogs not duly licensed
and furnished with collars as hereinbefore provided.
As soon as possible after taking up any dog the Constable
shall notify the owner, if known to him, stating
the fact; and if the license fee is not paid and
the animal reclaimed within twenty-four hours,
the same shall be killed by the Constable. The
Constable's fees for taking up and disposing of such
unlicensed dogs shall be fifty cents per head.
