

ORDINANCE # 37 36

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE # 34
OF THE VILLAGE OF GLYNDON, MINNESOTA,
AND RELATING TO THE LICENSING AND
REGULATING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION
OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF GLYNDON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 3, Subdivision 2 of Ordinance #34 of the Village of Glyndon is hereby amended so that after amendment it shall read as follows:

Subdivision 2. "On Sale" and "Off Sale" licenses shall be issued only to persons authorized to receive the same pursuant to Chapter 340, Minnesota Statutes Annotated. Not more than two "On Sale" licenses and one "Off Sale" licenses shall be granted by the Village of Glyndon at any one time. The "Off Sale" license may be issued to a holder of an "On Sale" license.

Section 4, Subdivision 1 of Ordinance #34 of the Village of Glyndon, Minnesota is hereby amended to read as follows after amendment:

Subdivision 1. Every application for a license to sell liquor shall be verified and filed with the Village Clerk. It shall state the name of the applicant, his age, representations as to his character with such references as may be required, his citizenship, whether the application is for an "On Sale" or an "Off Sale" license, the business in connection with which the proposed license will operate and its location, whether the applicant is the owner and operator, how long he has been in that business at that place and such other information as the Village Council may require from time to time. In addition to containing such information, each application for a license shall be in a form prescribed by the Liquor Control Commissioner. Any false statements made in the application for license shall be grounds for the denial of the same.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from
and after its passage and publication according to law.
