

ORDINANCES, RULES, REGULATIONS, AND BY-LAWS

Village of Glyndon, Clay County, Minn.

Village Ordinance No 4

An ordinance creating a Board of Health in the Village of Glyndon.

The Village Council of the Village of Glyndon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. There shall be in the Village of Glyndon, a board of health, composed of three members, one of whom shall be the executive officer of the board and be known as Health Officer. This official shall be a physician when there is one in the village and his services can be secured.

Section 2. The term of office of the members of this board shall be for three years except hereinafter ^{provided} and in case of filling vacancies caused by removals or resignations, the election or appointment shall be only for balance of unexpired term.

Section 3. The first election or appointment of members to compose this board shall be as follows: One member shall hold office for a term of three years, one for term of two years and the other for term of one year. Hereafter as above provided the term of office shall be three years.
