Village Ordinance No 6.

An ordinance relating to Drunkenness & Disorderly Conduct.  
The Village Council of the Village of Glyndon do ordain  
as follows:-

Sec. 1. Any person who shall be found within the  
limits of the village of Glyndon in a drunken  
condition, or using abusive, obscene or indecent language  
or in any manner being disorderly, shall, upon  
conviction of such an offense, be subject to a fine of not  
more than twenty dollars (\$20.00) together with the costs  
of prosecution, and in default of payment of such  
fine and costs shall be imprisoned in the county  
jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.
