

ORDINANCES, RULES, REGULATIONS, AND BY-LAWS

of the Village of Glyndon, Polk County, Minn.

Village Ordinance No 8

An ordinance relating to stock obstructing streets and sidewalks.

The village council of the Village of Glyndon do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful hereafter for any person to hitch, tie or stake in any manner, any horse, cattle or other stock so that same can enter or obstruct any sidewalk or street within the limits of this village.

Sec. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than five dollars (\$5.00) together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such fine and costs shall be imprisoned in the county jail not exceeding ten days.

Sec. 3. It is hereby made the duty of the constable or marshal of the village to make complaint and prosecute all violations of the provisions of this ordinance.
