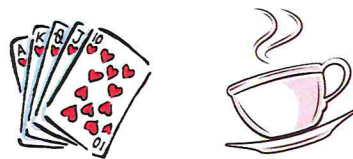

The second reading will be during the Council Meeting on Wednesday, May 8, 2024, at 7:00 AM

The ordinance be published in the Clay County Union and will into effect on June 3, 2024.
