### 2026 UTILITY RATE INCREASE



Starting on your December/January Utility bill you will notice a change with the Utility Rates:

- Water Base Rate will increase to \$35.00
- Sewer Base Rate will increase to \$25.00
- Clean-up Week will increase to \$2.40
- Forestry will increase to \$2.00
- Capital Project will increase to \$10.00

#### Reminder of Snow Removal Ordinance

#### #155

With winter right around the corner, this is a reminder to all residents to comply with City snow removal requirements.

**Per Ordinance #155, you may not move, blow, or plow snow off your property onto City streets or City rights-of-way.**

**As winter approaches, we want to remind residents that designated areas in town have parking restrictions from November through April. These rules help keep streets clear for snow removal and ensure safe travel for everyone.**
