2026 UTILITY RATE INCREASE



Starting on your December/January Utility bill you
will notice a change with the Utility Rates:

- Water Base Rate will increase to \$35.00
- Sewer Base Rate will increase to \$25.00
- Clean-up Week will increase to \$2.40
- Forestry will increase to \$2.00
- Capital Project will increase to \$10.00

Reminder of Snow Removal Ordinance #155
