### Business Spotlight

## Lupe's Tacos!

10 Partridge Ave N | Glyndon, MN 56547



Lupe's Tacos, a family-owned and operated food truck and catering business, was started in 1994 by Lupe and her husband Jesse as a way to pay for school supplies and other necessities for the family. For years, the only thing she sold was her famous Chicken Fajita Tacos (which remain a menu favorite to this day). She would set up at farmers markets and operate out of a tent. Around 2007, the business upgraded from a tent to their first food truck, the menu expanded and Lupe's Tacos began to reach more people. The family became more involved as the business grew, and in 2019 they upgraded their trucks—the same year Lupe's son, Jesse, took over the business alongside his sister Erica. In the last few years, Lupe's Tacos has added two other food trucks to their fleet and in November of 2024 opened a brick and mortar restaurant off Hwy 10 in Glyndon, MN!

Blending classic Tex-Mex with their own signature style, Lupe's Tacos is known for standout items like the Grande Burritos, Chicken Fajita Tacos, and Honey Sriracha Street Tacos. They've also expanded with a third truck, Chuy's Pizza and Wings. Across every location, the family stays true to Lupe's original recipes, simple ingredients, and bold, memorable flavors.
