The last day affidavits may be filed is Tuesday, July 28th, 2026, until 5:00 p.m. A candidate must be a resident of Glyndon, be at least 21 years of age, and will have maintained residency for 30 days prior to the election. There is a \$2.00 fee to file the affidavit.
