

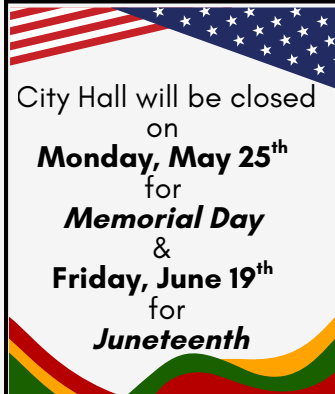

Friendly Reminder: Now that summer is upon us, it is your responsibility to maintain your yard, boulevard, and ditches. Keeping your yard tidy not only enhances the beauty of your home but also contributes to a pleasant and inviting neighborhood atmosphere.

Ordinance No. 117: Establishes requirements for grass mowing, weeds, downed trees, debris, etc.. Non-compliance could lead to financial penalties or other consequences.

There have been multiple reports of dogs NOT being leashed in town, causing issues for residents and fellow pet owners. Under City Ordinance #164, all pets must be leashed and under your control at all times.

Pet owners are responsible for properly cleaning up their dog's waste. In addition, all dogs and cats must be licensed with the City.
