1. Remember to contact **City Hall** to update your utility account information: Ph. **218-498-2578**. Our office hours are **Mon-Fri, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm**.
2. **Utility Bills** cover water, sewer, garbage, mosquito spraying, and other services. **These bills are due on the 20th of each month**. You can make these payments via **cash, check, or ACH** auto pay. If you would like to get set up for auto pay, call City Hall at 218-498-2578. ****Coming November 2020 = Online Payments!****
3. The City has garbage services through **Fuchs Sanitation**, and pick up day is on Wednesdays. **New 64-gallon roll off totes are provided to all residents and must be put out on Tuesday evening. No Parking is allowed on city streets on pick-up day until all totes have been emptied. Tote lids must be closed shut or they will not be emptied.** If you have any questions, please call **218-498-2875**.
4. Electric and gas services are provided through either **Xcel Energy** (residents living north of 9th Street), or through **Red River Valley Electric Cooperative** (residents living south of 9th Street).

5. Cable and internet services are either through **Arvig Communications**, or through **Midcontinent**.

7. Our **Recycling Center** is available for residents on **Tuesdays** and **Thursdays, 8:00 am to 4:30pm**, and on **Saturdays** from **8:00 am to 12:00 pm**. You will find it located between the Police Station and City Hall buildings on 3rd Street.
8. The **City Compost** site is located on the corner of 4th St and Eglon Ave, and is for grass clippings only. Large branches and other yard waste can be brought to the **burn pile** on 7th Street east of town.
