


## Tents/Tables & Chairs for Saturday's Activities


- Tent, 1 Table & 2 Chairs for Selling of Wrist Bands Money/Wrist Bands/Signs

If we have extra tents, we can set them up around so people can sit under them.


We can set out the blankets for people to sit on.

Hi Wendy,

Attached are some renderings showing the design we discussed for Johnson Park. I did add a couple of benches and a Revi wheel and Curva Spinner.

Here are current costs: Equipment - \$71,620.00

Wood Fiber - \$7,800.00

Containment borders - \$3200.00

I am estimating shipping costs for the equipment at \$1500 to \$2000.

Please note none of these include installation. As we discussed we could send out a foreman to supervise for 2 days to eet things started. That would run about \$2500.00 for 2 days.

I did note above these are current costs. There is already discussion of a price increase on the equipment coming early fall. I would guess that to be around 5%.
