
1. **Call to Order:** Mayor Cecil Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:00 a.m.


3. **Motion to Approve Resolution 2020-8 – Temporary Suspension of Certain Local Ordinances and Controls for Outdoor Food and Beverage Consumption to Aid Restaurants and Bars in Response to Minnesota’s COVID-19 Stay Safe Plan** – Mayor Johnson said this will take place immediately. Affield said once this is approved, local establishments can open right away, in accordance to the guidelines. She said if inclement weather occurs, patrons will not be allowed to move inside to eat, only to pack up their own food, pay their bill, use the restrooms, and go. The Hill’s safety plan was submitted to City Hall and looks good, she said. Schreiber asked if the other establishment in town decides to open, will another meeting need to be held? Affield said no, but they would be required to submit their own safety plan as well. A motion to approve Resolution 2020-8 was made by Justin Schreiber, seconded by Joe Olson. All in favor.


