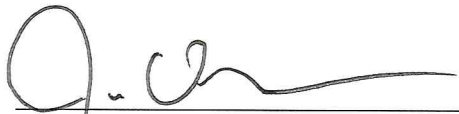
10. **Committee Reports** – Planning and Zoning met and discussed the City road plans for the future.

12. **Miscellaneous Announcements & Recognitions**

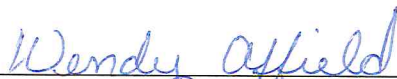
