ordinance no. 96

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OPEN BURNING OF DRIED LEAFS

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Glyndon and the Council does hereby ordain the following ordinance:

Section 1: The burning of dried leafs is hereby permitted within the corporate limits of the City of Glyndon in accordance with the provisions and conditions hereinafter set forth in this ordinance.

Section 2: The burning of dried leafs shall be permitted to occur from September 15 to December 1 of each year between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 9:00 P.M.

Section 3: The only substances to be burned in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance shall be dried leafs.

Section 4: Notwithstanding the foregoing, no burning of leafs shall take place during any air pollution alert, warning or emergency declared by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency nor shall any burning take place during a fire danger alert declared by the fire department of the City of Glyndon or by the Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources.

Section 5: No person shall ignite or burn any dried leafs upon the land of any other person without the express permission of the owner thereof or of his agent nor shall any person ignite or burn any dried leafs on any publicly owned or controlled lot or parcel of land or public bridge, street, sidewalk or other public place which has not been expressly set aside by public authorities for such purpose.

Section 6: Any fire authorized by this ordinance shall be constantly attended by a competent person until such fire is fully extinguished. This person shall have a garden hose connected to a water supply or other fire extinguishing equipment readily available for use at the site of such fire.

Section 7: Violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be considered a petty misdemeanor. A third violation and all subsequent violations within a one-year period of time shall constitute a misdemeanor.
