## CITY OF GLYNDON ORDINANCE NO. 139

## AN ORDINANCE ADDING TO EXISTING ORDINANCE NO. 58 WHICH RELATES TO OPEN BOTTLE OR CONTAINER WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF GLYNDON

- SECTION 1 OPEN BOTTLE LAW: No persons shall mix or prepare liquor for consumption, nor shall any persons consume any intoxicating liquor or nonintoxicating malt liquor, nor shall any persons have in their possession in an open container any intoxicating liquor or nonintoxicating malt liquor in any public place or place of business not licensed to self intoxicating liquor or nonintoxicating malt liquor on sale. No persons shall consume nor shall any persons have in their possession an open container of intoxicating liquor or nonintoxicating malt liquor in any motor vehicle on within the City at any time.
- SECTION 2 PENALTY: The violation of this Ordinance is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor and any person so violating the same shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed (\$700 as of publication date) or by confinement in the Clay County Jail for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
