mentioned has been one of the printers.....of the MOORHEAD DAILY NEWS, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the legal publication hereinafter described, said newspaper has been and is a daily newspaper printed and published in the City of Moorhead, County of Clay, State of Minnesota, every day (except Sundays and holidays) of each week; that during all that time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the city from which it purports to be issued as above stated in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column two inches wide; has been issued from a known office established in said place of publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same; that part of the press work is done in its known office of publication; that in its makeup not less than twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patent, plate matter and advertisements; that it has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and had entry as second class matter in its local post-office; and that there is on file in the office of the County Auditor of Clay County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper; and that its publishers have complied with all demands of said County Auditor for proofs of its said qualifications.
