ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 37 WHICH ORDINANCE NO. 37 REGULATES HOUSE TRAILERS, TRAILERS, TRAILER COACHES AND MOBILE HOMES IN THE VILLAGE OF GLYNDON.

Be it enacted by the village council of the Village of Glyndon

Section 1. Section 8 of Ordinance #37, which ordinance regulates house trailers, trailers, trailer coaches and mobile homes in the village of Glyndon, is hereby amended so that after amended said Section 8 shall read as follows:

"Section 8. The establishment of a trailer park in the Village of Glyndon is hereby prohibited except upon compliance with all state laws and regulations and only after the adoption of a resolution of the village council of the Village of Glyndon approving the same. Before the village council shall approve the same such person desiring the establishment of said trailer park shall file with the village council complete plans and specifications for the same and said plans and specifications shall show all sewer and water installations and ground levels for drainage purposes. After the establishment of a trailer park in the Village of Glyndon and approval of the same by the village council, no person shall thereafter be permitted to park or place a trailer coach, trailer house or mobile home on the premises of any dwelling or upon any vacant lot in the Village of Glyndon. This Ordinance shall, however, not affect those trailer coaches, trailer houses or mobile homes which have been parked or placed prior to the enactment of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage and publication.
