

ORDINANCE NO. 100

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF GLYNDON FROM TWO YEARS TO FOUR YEARS BEGINNING WITH THE TERM OF OFFICE TO COMMENCE JANUARY, 1985.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Glyndon as follows:

Section 1: The purpose of this ordinance is to change the term of office of the Mayor of the City of Glyndon from a term of two years to a term of four years beginning with the term of office to commence January, 1985, said change to be in accordance with Minnesota Statutes Section 412.022.

Section 2: The term of office of Mayor of the City of Glyndon shall be for a period of four years per term commencing with the term of office starting January, 1985.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be effective for the election to be held November, 1984, for the term of office commencing January, 1985, and shall be adopted from and after the passage and publication of this ordinance as provided by law.
