

ORDINANCE NO. 51

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 39, WHICH ORDINANCE NO. 39 REGULATES THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS, PRIVATE SEWER DISPOSAL, THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF PRIVATE SEWERS TO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM, THE DISCHARGE OF WATER AND WASTE INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM, PRESCRIBING THE RULES AND RATES FOR THE OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS OF PROPERTY NOW CONNECTED OR HEREAFTER CONNECTED WITH THE PUBLIC SEWAGE SYSTEM IN THE VILLAGE OF GLYNDON AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED by the Village Council of the Village of Glyndon as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 9, Subdivision E of Ordinance No. 39, which Ordinance regulates the use of public and private sewers and prescribes the rules and rates for the owners and occupants of property connected with the public sewage system in the Village of Glyndon, is hereby amended so that after amendment, said Section 9, Subdivision E shall read as follows:


SECTION 9, Subdivision E: The funds received from the collection of charges for rentals authorized by this Ordinance shall be deposited as collected in a fund to be known as the Sewage Disposal Fund and said funds may be used by the Village of Glyndon to meet the costs of operation and maintenance of the sewage disposal plant and may also be used to meet the costs of operation and maintenance of the water treatment plant. Said funds may also be used for the construction and replacement of the sewage disposal plant or the construction and replacement of the water treatment plant or said funds may be applied to capital charges represented by bonds of the Village or any interest thereon.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage and publication.
